



## 2026 Summer Camp Volunteer Requirements

### Volunteer Position Overview:

The Summer Camp Leader in Training (LIT) program is a volunteer opportunity for high school-aged youth who are interested in developing leadership skills and gaining hands-on experience working with children. LITs who successfully complete the full week of camp earn 40 volunteer hours. This role requires **maturity, responsibility, and the ability to serve as a positive role model for campers.**

LITs assist with daily programming such as arts and crafts, games, and special events for children ages 5 to 12. Responsibilities include helping with activity set up, execution, and clean up; engaging campers in a positive and encouraging way; reinforcing camp rules and expectations set by leaders; and helping to maintain a safe, inclusive, and supportive camp environment.

### Position Responsibilities:

- Assist with supervising and supporting your designated group of children
- Actively participate in and help lead activities such as crafts, games, and special events
- Encourage participants to respect and follow camp rules and expectations, modeling appropriate behavior at all times
- Ensure the safety and well being of campers by acting responsibly and thinking like a leader
- Follow the designated dress code, including wearing the SNA t-shirt during program hours
- Adhere to all SNA policies and procedures
- Arrive on time and prepared for each day of camp, and communicate promptly with staff if you will be late or absent due to illness
- Throughout the week, work toward building confidence and comfort in working cooperatively with peers and engaging positively with children

### Additional Requirements

- Must be going into grade 9 -12 in the fall of 2026.
- Able to be a good role model around younger campers
- Able to follow directions from summer camp leaders
- There is no previous experience or training required!
